THE DAY

A day is one operational period: 15 hours. Every rate includes the edit. The record delivers before the period ends.

THE SEATS // PER DAY

Photo documentation	\$4,500	\$300	100+ verified frames, timestamped
Video documentation	\$4,500	\$300	60-90 sec recap, 2-4 work clips, b-roll archive

Media liaison	\$2,625	\$175	PIO support, press management on scene

Two rates, two kinds of seats: the ones that build the record and the ones that support it. One person carries one lens. Two days or less bills crew rate only.

THE FOUR RULES // NOTHING ELSE MOVES THE NUMBER

01 THE DAY	A day is one operational period: 15 hours. Seats times days. The record delivers before the period ends.
02 THE DISTANCE	Three days or more bills one crew day rate to mobilize and demobilize. Half out, half back. Two days or less, we rough it out.
03 THE DEPLOYMENT	Past 48 hours, the deployment package activates: command trailer, satellite connectivity, power, HVAC, vehicles. \$7,850 per day, sleeps four. Per diem \$250 per person per day. Self-contained, so we never draw down local resources.
04 THE HEADCOUNT	Past four deployed, the kit rolls: bunk trailer, \$2,500 per day. Bathroom trailer, fully serviced, \$4,500 per day. Up to ten. Past ten is a custom scope.

The rate does not change when the storm hits. Crews run one to ten deployed; past ten is a custom scope, on IAP terms. The record belongs to the client. Full rights, forever. Timestamped, verified, nothing staged, delivered same day.
